



In January we will visit the extensive and varied shows in Quartzsite, Arizona. Our timing is to take advantage of the annual "Pow Wow", hosted by the Quartzsite Improvement Association, and many of our members will meet there on the first day of the Pow Wow, which is January 17th in order to have an opportunity to see more of the shows while they are there.

Our PLS field trips are Saturday and Sunday. The time and location of where we will meet will be posted as soon as it is available.

We will be camping at the Plomosa Road BLM open camping area, approximately 10 miles north of Quartzsite.

Directions coming from the West on I-10:

- From the western exit to Quartzsite, turn left over the Interstate and right on Main Street.
- At the traffic light turn left (north) on U.S. Hwy 95.
- Drive 5.67 miles and turn right on Plomosa Road.
- The BLM camping area is on the right (40617 Plomosa Road). There is free camping in this area. We will be camping in an area where there are other mineral clubs gathering on the south side of Plomosa Road. Look for PLS or P/W signs for our camping area. If you don't see our signs, look for YOTMC signs and ask for Dick Pankey who will know where our folks are. More information at the monthly meeting. Of course, if you are planning to stay in a motel in Blythe you should make a reservation immediately.

Start out going north on AZ-95/N Central
