

Directions To Frog Meadows Camp From Pasadena

Directions to the campsite at the Greenhorn Mountains from Pasadena

- 1. Take the I-210 W/Foothill Fwy West becomes I-5 N/Golden State Fwy N I-5 north.
- 2. Once over the Tejon Pass, watch for the intersection of CA-99. Keep left to take CA-99 N via EXIT 221 toward Bakersfield/Fresno.
- 3. In 24.0 miles merge onto CA-58 E via EXIT 24 toward Tehachapi/Mojave.
- 4. In 7.0 miles take the Weedpatch Hwy/CA-184 exit, EXIT 117, toward Lamont. Turn left onto CA-184/CA-58 Business / Weedpatch Hwy. Continue to follow CA-184 for 1.7 mi.
- 5. Turn right onto CA-184 / Kern Canyon Road. CA-184 is 0.1 miles past Polaris Avenue. There is a SHELL gas station on the corner.
- 6 In 2.5 miles turn right onto Highway 178/CA-178. Continue to follow CA-178 for 32.8 miles.
- 7. Take the CA-155 exit, EXIT 43, toward Lake Isabella/Kernville. Turn left onto CA-155/ Highway 155. Continue to follow CA-155 for 6.6 miles, then turn left onto Evans Rd/CA-155 for another 6.6 miles. Turn left to stay on Evans Rd/CA-155. This is WOFFORD HEIGHTS, CA. Look for the Greenhorn Mountain County Park.
- 8. From the Greenhorn Mountain Park:
- 1. Continue onto Wofford Blvd 0.9 mi
- 2. Turn right onto CA-155 W/Evans Rd 7.5 mi
- 3. Take Forest Rte 23S16 to Forest Rte 24S50 in Tulare County 54 min (13.8 mi)
- 4. Turn right onto Rancheria Rd 1.2 mi
- 5. Turn left onto Forest Rte 23S16/Rancheria Rd 5.9 mi
- 6. Turn right onto Forest Rte 23S16 0.2 mi
- 7. Turn right to stay on Forest Rte 23S16 2.1 mi
- 8. Slight left 2.7 mi
- 9. Slight left onto Forest Rte 24S50 1.8 mi
- 10. Camp near junction of Forest Route 24S50

13 miles north of Greenhorn Mountain County Park into the Sequoia National Forest. Camp is called the Frog Meadow Camp, off Highway 155. Watch for signs for the Conejo Gem and Mineral Club (CGMC). GPS coordinate is N35 52.23.10' W118 34.44.12'.
