Click on the JOIN GROUP button at the top of the web page. Follow the instructions to establish your own free Yahoo Identity.

Then you'll be able to access our FILES area, PHOTOS area, and a searchable archive of all messages posted to the list.

The rules are simple.

- No spamming is allowed.
- Keep your messages on-topic, courteous, and civil.
- No politics or personal attacks will be tolerated.
- Occasional ads are fine so long as the item is rockhound-related and so long as advertising isn't the main reason for your posts on this forum.

If you want to send a message to everyone on the list, address it to LA-Rocks@yahoogroups.com It will go out to 1200+ people. Please note that when you do an auto-reply to a list message, your email is not sent to the entire list, only back to the author of the message. I've set up the reply function this way to cut down the amount of extraneous message traffic. The list's web page is <http://www.yahoogroups.com/group/la-rocks/>

You'll find a searchable archive of all messages that have ever been sent out, so you can look for "Trona" or "garnets". You'll also find a number of files containing pictures, documents, schedules, and lists of information that folks on the list have uploaded.

Ordinarily, all messages will come to you as separate emails, but if you prefer to read these messages on the Web or if you'd like to change to the Digest Mode where you get one summary message each day, go to <https://groups.yahoo.com/neo/groups/LA-Rocks/info> sign in with your Yahoo ID, and select your preference.

If you ever want to be removed from the list, send an email to LA-Rocks-unsubscribe@yahoogroups.com or go to the Yahoogroups web page and click Unsubscribe.

After you've had a chance to read the mail for a while, I invite you to introduce yourself in a message to the list. Much of the fun is in getting to know each other.
