

Quartzsite Roadrunners Gem and Mineral Club 2016 Pow Wow field trips

In addition to a fabulous show, the Quartzsite club will have field trips to some of their favorite places. Here is how you can attend these trips:

1. For insurance reasons, only members and those buying a temporary membership are allowed to go on the field trips. Visitors can buy a temporary membership for \$2/trip.
2. There are two field trips per day. Both of the trips leave at the same time, at 9am.
3. Pick the trip you would like to participate in and be at the meeting location at 8:30am Arizona (Mountain) Time.
4. Meet at the particular departure site (N, S, E or W). Sign up is at 8:30am and departure at 9:00am.
5. There will take two trips per day and both will be in the mornings.

January 20th, Wednesday

- A. Green banded Rhyolite - North
- B. Chalcedony [desert roses] - South

January 21st, Thursday

- A. Mushroom Rhyolite - Mushroom Rhyolite
- B. Porcelain Jasper - West

January 22nd, Friday

- A. Red, White and Blue Jasper - East
- B. Jasper Hematite - North

January 23rd, Saturday

- A. Birdseye Rhyolite - South
- B. Pastelite - West

January 24th, Sunday

- A. Alunite - West
- B. Agate/Fossils - North

Departure Sites:

East: From the stop light on Hwy 95 South & E. Kuehn St. (south side of hwy 95 overpass) go east on E. Kuehn St. for .9 miles to the intersection of E. Kuehn St. & Riggles Ave. (Riggles Ave. is I-10 Exit 19 crossover south end) Line up on the north east corner on E. Kuehn St.

North: Hwy 95 North (Central Blvd.) go 1.5 mi. to Tyson Road, then East 1/4 mi. Park on the north side of the road facing west.

South: Hwy 95 South and Kuehn St., (south side of hwy 95 overpass) go south 1 mile to Mile Post 103. Park on the right (west) side of the road.

West: From the stop light at Hwy. 95 & Kuehn St. (south side of I-10), go 2.1 miles to just east of the Super 8 Motel and park on the north side of the road. From the Love's Station it is .6 miles. (Exit 17 on I-10)

All the details should be online by the first of January at <http://qrgmc.org/> and will also be available at in printed form at the QRGMC booth and the info desk inside the QIA building during the Pow Wow.

You can also purchase raffle tickets for great prizes at their booth! Drawings are held every day of the Pow Wow every 15 minutes.
